3 Purpose of Processing

We process your personal data for the following purposes:

- Providing and documenting veterinary services
- Issuing invoices and processing payments
- Accounting and, if necessary, credit checks
- Managing animal and owner data
- Ensuring the preservation of information regarding the course of treatment and associated risks
- Attaching stall signs with relevant information
- Reporting to authorities (e.g., Veterinary Association, Veterinary Office)
- Use of images for promotional purposes
- Compliance with legal regulations and contractual obligations
- Contacting and communicating with you (including for promotional purposes, if applicable)

4 Legal Basis for Processing

Your data is processed in connection with the treatment of your animal and related communications on the basis of Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR. The disclosure of your personal data to the Veterinary Association or the Veterinary Office occurs exclusively in accordance with legal requirements pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR. If you wish to pay for the treatment by invoice, a credit check may be conducted, which is based on our legitimate interest in ensuring payment is received, in accordance with Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR.

If you have given us your consent, the legal basis for the processing is Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR.



5 Recipients of Data

Your personal data will be disclosed, as necessary and exclusively for the purposes listed above, to:

- Veterinarians providing (further) treatment within the TeamVet network or externally
- Laboratories, farriers, and other service providers
- The Veterinary Medical Association, the Veterinary Office
- Credit reporting agencies
- Billing service providers
- Software service providers

6 Data Storage

Once collected, your data will be stored by us only for as long as is necessary to fulfill the respective tasks, in compliance with statutory retention periods.

7 Obligation to Provide Personal Data

The provision of certain personal data is required by law or contract, or is necessary for the conclusion or performance of a contract. Without this data, it is not possible to fulfill the respective obligation or perform the contract. The specific data required in each case is determined by the applicable legal requirements or contractual provisions.

8 Rights of User and Data Subjects

Data subjects, provided they meet the legal requirements, have the right to:

- Access their data pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR,
- Rectification of inaccurate data pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR,
- Erasure of their data pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR,
- Restriction of processing pursuant to Art. 18 of the GDPR,
- Objection to certain processing activities pursuant to Art. 21 of the GDPR,
- Withdrawal of consent pursuant to Art. 7(3) of the GDPR, and
- Lodging a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority pursuant to Art. 77 of the GDPR.
